

# PRIVACY NOTICE

## of the Company Sardinia Yacht Services

In pursuance of art. 13 of the EU Regulation 2016/679

In compliance with the relevant European regulations governing the protection of personal data, defined in accordance with the provisions contained in EU Regulation 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 (hereinafter referred to as "GDPR"), We inform you that the personal data provided or otherwise acquired shall be processed in full compliance with fundamental freedoms, by always adopting principles of fairness, lawfulness and transparency, and for purposes not excessive in relation to the purpose for which they are collected, in such a way to guarantee the protection and confidentiality of the data themselves.

### 1 – Purposes of data processing

Personal data you provided and we collected in compliance with the relevant regulations shall be used:

for the performance of activities and services you requested, for the execution of the agreements made with you, or before the termination of the said, as well as for operational management requirements.

Legal basis :

Execution of an agreement/service for the operational management strictly related to any possible conclusion of agreements or provision of the service requested.

Execution of pre-contractual measures to fulfill the obligations provided for by national and community laws and regulations in force.

Legal obligation for the management of any litigation which may arise due to non compliance with contracts, transactions, debt collection, legal disputes.

### 2 – Methods of data processing

Data processing shall be carried out with the aid of paper, IT, digital, electronic or automated means, even entrusting it to third parties, who were appointed on purpose, and it shall be performed in accordance with logics strictly related to the purposes indicated, according to the principles of lawfulness and transparency, and in any case, in such a way to protect the privacy and rights of the data subject, in full compliance with what provided for by the regulations in force.

### 3 – Provision of data

Without prejudice to the personal autonomy of the person concerned the provision of personal data is compulsory for the purposes mentioned in the previous point 1 and therefore any possible refusal to provide them may lead to the impossibility for Sardinia Yacht Services srl to execute the aforesaid relationships.

### 4 – Persons authorized to data processing and Subjects or categories of subjects to which data may be communicated

Without prejudice to any communication made in compliance with the law Your personal data may be communicated for the purposes established in paragraph 1, to:

- Banks and credit institutions

- professional, consulting and audit firms
- internal and external subjects specifically appointed for the performance of the service.

Personal data collected are also processed by the staff in charge, which was duly trained and having specific requirements for the execution of its own activities, as well as by subjects appointed as company external processors.

The updated list of any possible data processor to whom data are communicated is at your disposal, upon request. Personal data shall not be subject to disclosure, except for the cases envisaged by the law.

## 5 – Duration of processing and data retention times

Processing and retention of your personal data shall be performed in compliance with what provided for by the law in force on this matter, for a period of time not longer than necessary for the achievement of the purposes established in the previous point 1 for which they are processed, without prejudice to the ten-year period for the retention of data that have a civil nature and for the fulfillment of any other legal obligations.

## 6 – Rights of the data subjects

In relation to Your personal data processed by Sardinia Yacht Services Srl, You are entitled to the rights provided by the GDPR on the person concerned, as follows:

- the confirmation that your personal data are being processed and, in such case, the access to them (right of access);
- the copy of personal data You have provided and the transfer of data which may be directly transferred to another controller you may have indicated (right of portability);
- the rectification or integration of Your personal data owned by Sardinia Yacht Services Srl (right of rectification);
- the cancellation of any data for which there is no longer any legal ground for processing (right to be forgotten);
- the revocation of Your consent, in the event that processing is grounded on the consent, without prejudice to the lawfulness of processing based on the consent given before revocation (right of revocation of the consent);
- the limitation of processing in the cases established by GDPR (limitation right);
- the opposition in the event that processing is grounded on the legitimate interest or is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or related to the exercise of official authority (right of opposition).
- The right to lodge a complaint to the supervisory authority (Privacy Guarantor) (right of complaint).

Sardinia Yacht Services Srl, shall promptly reply to any requests for information or requests for the exercise of Your rights, as well as in relation to any complaints You lodged as regards the processing of your personal data, in compliance with what provided for by applicable laws.
